


Create order from favorites

To create a new order from your favorites, follow these steps:

1. Click **+ Create**, the following window appears:

2. Select the favorite tag from which you want to create the order, you can also select the favorite tags shared by other users,

3. Select the customer, this option is only available if the selected customer is “Full Range”,
4. Select the location to which you want to add the order,
5. Enter the order alias and customer reference, if you want, each in its field,
6. Click **Save**. The order is created as shown in the below example and it has the articles added to the favorites tag you selected as shown below:
