


## Manage vetting list

You can add values for bucket attributes to enable users to select any of those values. To do so, follow these steps:

1. Select **Manage vetting list** from the Actions menu next to the attribute you want, the following window appears:

2. Select the attribute to which you want to add values,

4. Enter the criteria you want in JSON format, if you want this attribute to be dependent on another attribute or more,
