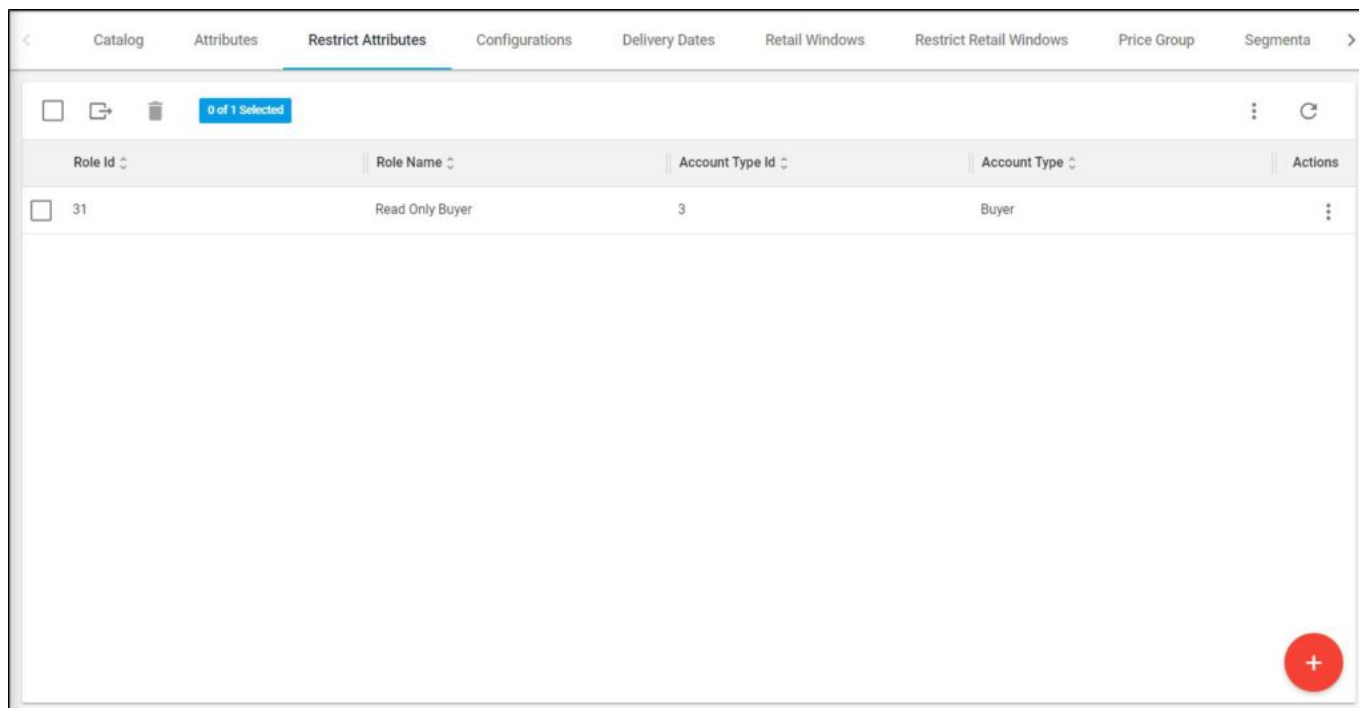


Restrict attributes
