



Update segmentation for multiple articles

To update segmentations for multiple articles, follow these steps:

1. Click the checkbox(es) next to the articles you want,
2. Click  , the following window appears:



2. Click the checkbox next to the segmentation you want to update, unchecked checkboxes will remain unchanged,
3. Click the slider button next to the segmentation you want to assign to the article(s), the selected segmentation will be marked with "Yes", while the other segmentations will be marked with "No". If you select Open, all segmentations are assigned to the selected articles,
4. Click **Save**, a progress window is displayed and segmentations are updated.


- If a segmentation group is added to the selected catalog, the window appears as shown below:
